

School District Organization

School District Legal Status

Community Unit School District 9, Madison County, Illinois, was established August 2, 1950, after a vote of the people of the territory involved on July 29, 1950. This election was held in accordance with the provisions of the Community Unit Reorganization Act passed by the Legislature in 1945 and amended in 1947. The territory included in the election was School District No. 126U, Granite City Elementary School; No. 154, Nameoki Elementary School; No. 139, Stallings Elementary School; No. 111, Central Rural Elementary School; No. 108, St. Thomas Rural Elementary School; No. 110, Atkins Rural Elementary School; No. 114, Sand Prairie Rural Elementary School; No. 149, Granite City Community High School. In 1951, District No. 109, Mitchell Rural Elementary School, petitioned the court to be annexed to Community Unit District No. 9, Madison County, Illinois. On May 4, 1951, petition was heard without objections and granted by Judge Michael Kinney. The School District was annexed July 1, 1951. The School District operates under The School Code of Illinois.
