CITIZEN PARTICIPATION AT BOARD MEETINGS

The Granite City Board of Education welcomes visitors – including employees, students, parents and other citizens – to its regular meetings. To accommodate the public, certain rules have been established.

Interested persons are allowed to appear before the Board at open meetings to address the Board on board business.

RULES OF ORDER

1. Persons interested in addressing the Board shall sign a request form prior to the beginning of the meeting, with the secretary to the Board of Education. The time set aside for this purpose shall not exceed ten (10) minutes.
2. Each presentation shall be in consonance with good taste and decorum befitting the occasion and the dignity of the meeting. Shouting, loud statements, threats, name calling, offensive personal references or other improper conduct are strictly forbidden.
3. Each presentation may be limited to two to five (2-5) minutes per speaker
