The federal No Child Left Behind Act requires schools identified for year two of school improvement or corrective action to offer supplemental educational services to students from low-income families. The term "supplemental educational services," also referred to as SES, refers to extra instructional help provided to students in reading and math.

While the District wants to accommodate every request for supplemental education of services, it may not be possible depending on the number of requests. The following order determines which requests will receive priority:

- Students not meeting performance standards in reading and math who are eligible for the federal Free Breakfast or Lunch Program.
- Students not meeting performance standards in reading or math who are Lunch Program.
- Students not meeting performance standards in reading and man who are ligible for the federal Reduced Breakfast or Lunch program.
- Students not meeting performance standards in reading of math who are eligible for the federal Reduced Breakfast or Lunch Program.
- Students eligible for free or reduced breakfast or kind. Programs
