The federal No Child Left Behind Act requires schools identified for year two of school improvement or corrective action to offer supplemental educational services to students from low-income families. The term "supplemental educational services," also referred to as SES, refers to extra instructional help provided to students in reading and math.

If you would like supplemental educational services for your child, please mail this form no later than ______. Upon receiving the completed form, we will provide you with a description of State-approved supplemental service providers from which you may choose.

While the District wants to accommodate every request for supplemental educational services, it may not be possible depending on the number of requests. The following order determines which requests will receive priority:

- Students not meeting performance standards in reading **and** math who are eligible for the federal Free Breakfast or Lunch Program.
- Students not meeting performance standards in reading **or** math who are eligible for the federal Free Breakfast or Lunch Program.
- Students not meeting performance standards in reading **and** math who are eligible for the federal Reduced Breakfast or Lunch program.
- Students not meeting performance standards in reading **or** math who are eligible for the federal Reduced Breakfast or Lunch Program.
- Students eligible for free or reduced breakfast **or** lunch programs.
