Administrative Procedure – Holidays

Schools shall be closed on the following legal school Holidays:

January 1	-	New Year's Day
Third Monday in January	-	Dr. Martin Luther King's Birthday
February 12	-	Abraham Lincoln's Birthday
First Monday in March	-	Casimir Pulaski's Birthday
	-	Good Friday
Memorial Day	-	(as designated by Federal Law)
July 4	-	Independence Day
First Monday In September	-	Labor Day
Second Monday in October	-	Columbus Day
November 11	-	Veterans' Day
	-	Thanksgiving Day
December 25	-	Christmas Day

COMMEMORATIVE HOLIDAYS are regular school days devoted to the commemoration of specified patriotic, civic, cultural or historical persons or occasions. On Commemorative Holidays, teachers and students shall devote a portion of the school day to study and honor the person or occasion that is the subject of the holiday. Commemorative holidays are as follows:

Christa McAuliffe Day	-	January 28
Susan B. Anthony's Birthday	-	February 15
Viet Nam War Veterans' Day	-	March 29
Korean War Veterans' Day	-	The school day immediately preceding Veterans' Day
Pearl Harbor Veterans' Day	-	December 7
Recycling Day	-	October 1

Any other days so appointed by the President or Governor.
